

## Meter Fee Quote – Explanation of Fees

**Hot Tap Fee** – cost of hot tapping the distribution main, installing the lateral and meter box

**Anode Fee** – cost to install an anode to prevent corrosion if hot tapping a steel pipe

**Meter Cost** – cost of the physical meter installed, based on size

**Meter Relocation Fee** – cost to have the meter relocated at the time distribution main is constructed fronting customer’s property or in the event a customer wants to relocate their meter

- **Abandon Service Fee** – cost in the event a customer would like to relocate their existing service, this fee is to abandon and remove the existing service

**Resource Management Fee** – required by Metropolitan Water District of Southern California for water resource conservation program

**Backflow Testing Fee** – cost to perform initial testing and certification of backflow device prior to activating new service

**Paving Fee** – cost to re-pave the road after a service has been installed

- *High Traffic = E. G. > Van Buren, Alessandro, Wood, Cajalco, El Sobrante, Sycamore Canyon, etc.*

**Water Connection Fee** – funds utilized to pay for the water distribution system expansion; fees are calculated based upon the additional demand the new service will place on the system

**Jumper Fee** – cost for 3 months of unmetered water usage required for testing the water system

**Sewer Connection Fee** - reflects the costs for treatment and conveyance system capacity

**Mapping Fee** – cost to add the facilities to WMWD GIS mapping application

**Inspection Fee** – cost of inspecting construction of facilities by Western Inspector and internal staff time to manage and process the project flow

**Plan Check Deposit/Augmentation** – cost of reviewing plans for adherence to WMWD standards

- Pipeline Extension - Minimum \$13,000
- Commercial - Minimum \$13,000
- Onsite Irrigation (Recycled Water) - Minimum \$10,000

**Annexation Fees** – acreage and processing fees required to annex a property into WMWD and Metropolitan Water District of Southern California
